

Lumsden Beach Camp

Artist-in-Residence - Summer 2018

Founded in 1905, Lumsden Beach Camp (LBC) is the oldest summer camp in Western Canada. The camp operates overnight camps for children and youth ages 5-18 years. It is located on Last Mountain Lake, just beyond the village of Lumsden Beach, about 40 minutes north of Regina. LBC is proud to own 267 acres of land, including lakefront, beach, hills and brush, and native prairie pasture land.

The summer of 2018 will mark LBC's fourth year of hosting Artists-in-Residence. This summer we are looking to engage Indigenous artists working from any discipline.

We're eager to hear from artists, who identify as Indigenous, who are interested in living and working as a part of our camp community for at least some part of **June 18-August 31, 2018**. In addition to presenting a hands-on program to campers ages 5-17, artists will be asked to share details of their professional practice and artistic process. Preference will be given to artists whose practice focuses on community building, nature, or environmentalism. We are eager to have two or more, artists, from different disciplines, share the residency and be at the camp at different times.

Submission Details

To apply, please include the following in clearly labeled email attachments:

- Artist CV;
- 5-10 samples of work (photos, writing, video, MP3, etc);
- a brief narrative (maximum 1-page) outlining your experience working with youth, how a summer at camp could impact your professional practice, and examples of the types of sessions you may lead as part of your outreach plan.

Lumsden Beach Camp Support

- Artists will be compensated for days and/or half days spent working at the camp.
- Travel to LBC will be reimbursed at \$0.32/KM to a maximum of \$300 for the contract term.
- A materials budget will be supplied.
- A dedicated studio space, and room and board will be provided.
