

AQUATICS COORDINATOR (SEASONAL)

Compensation: \$7,000 for the period. Lodging and meals are provided during the full-time period. An additional stipend will be paid during May & June to offset food costs.

Position Overview

The Aquatics Coordinator is responsible for maintaining the pool and pool equipment, supervising and leading water activities, and ensuring a fun, safe waterfront experience for campers. This role leads games and/or lessons in the pool for much of the day and plans and runs Beach Day one day each week for the full camp at Lumsden Beach. The Aquatics Coordinator also maintains canoes, kayaks, lifejackets, paddles, and other waterfront supplies.

Outside of aquatics responsibilities, the Aquatics Coordinator participates in the life and fun of camp, joining hikes, leading a campfire skit, and helping with shared camp duties as needed. This position works alongside the Camp Director and Program Coordinator to ensure campers are safe, engaged, and having an amazing time. A great candidate is creative, safety-minded, and thrives working outdoors in a team environment.

On-site requirement: The successful candidate must live on-site for the duration of the term.

Qualifications & Requirements

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills; able to communicate with children, parents/guardians, and staff of all ages
- Physical and mental endurance to work long days in the summer months
- Ability to work up to 7 consecutive days per week during the summer months
- Flexible, cooperative, and willing to work in a team staff environment

Education & Experience

- Current National Lifeguard (NLS) certification
- Current Standard First Aid (or equivalent) and CPR Level C
- Aquatics Emergency Care certification
- Grade 12 completion; must be 18 years of age or older
- Pool Operator Course certificate (or willingness to complete)
- Previous experience with canoeing, camping, and working with children is an asset

Knowledge, Skills & Attributes

- Excellent risk assessment skills and strong safety-mindedness
- Well-developed interpersonal and relationship-building skills
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Strong desire and ability to work in a team and supervise children and youth

Key Responsibilities

- Water Safety & Program Delivery
- Plan, organize, and supervise all water activities at camp, including lifeguarding and water safety
- Instruction
- Lead skill development instruction, free swims (pool and/or lake), water games, and canoeing
- Maintain safe supervision practices and respond appropriately to incidents or changing conditions
- Maintain the pool and pool area, including equipment and cleanliness
- Maintain canoes and waterfront equipment (canoes/kayaks, paddles, lifejackets, and related supplies)
- Support safe, organized access to all waterfront programming

Camp-Wide Leadership & Support

- Plan and run Beach Day one day each week for the full camp at Lumsden Beach
- Support evening activities and special events for campers as needed
- Fill in for other paid or volunteer roles when required
- Participate fully in camp life (campfires, vespers, meals, wide games, etc.)
