The ideal candidate enjoys working outdoors, can work independently, and takes pride in maintaining a welcoming camp environment. Must be able to live on-site during staff training and throughout the camp season.

### **Requirements & Qualifications**

- Have completed Grade 12 and be 18 years of age or older
- Hold a valid Class 5 driver's licence and have access to a vehicle
- Have the physical and mental stamina to work long summer days
- Be able to work up to 6 consecutive days per week
- Be able to live on-site during staff training and throughout the camp season
- Be dependable, responsible, mature, self-motivated, and safety conscious
- Be able to work independently and follow written and verbal instructions
- Be flexible, cooperative, and willing to work with a team of young staff and volunteers

Assets:

- Summer camp experience
- Experience with manual labour and/or working in the trades
- WHMIS training / knowledge of handling hazardous materials
- Pool Operator's Course Certificate (or willingness to obtain)

### **Key Responsibilities**

#### **Site Maintenance & Daily Operations**

- Complete daily task lists (e.g., garbage removal, washroom cleaning, water testing, basic repairs, etc.)

- Respond to maintenance needs as they arise to support campers, staff, renters, and volunteers
- Monitor cleaning and paper supply inventory and order supplies as needed
- Maintain camp grounds (mowing, weed trimming around buildings, tree trimming, garden care, etc.)

### **Repairs & General Maintenance**

- Perform general maintenance as needed (painting, patching screens, repairing decks, fixing stairs, etc.)
  - Identify issues that require specialized skills and help source the right person/support when needed
  - Assist the Aquatics Coordinator with basic swimming pool maintenance
  - Take on other duties as assigned by the Camp Director
